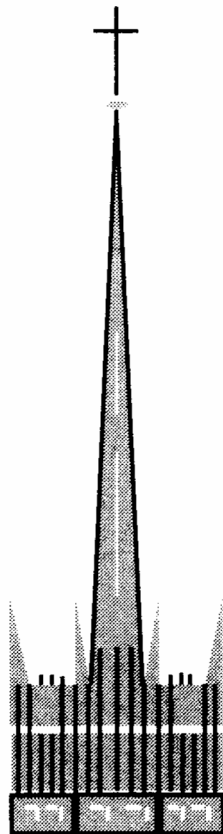

## Music at Blackburn Cathedral

We have over 150 singers in eight choirs at the cathedral, boys and girls, teenagers, men and women, all of whom are entirely voluntary. Our girls and boys (who all come from local schools) receive the equivalent of £1,000 free tuition in music every year. The high standards reached help them with their schoolwork, for their ability to concentrate is enhanced. And they enjoy it!

Our choirs broadcast regularly for BBC Radio and also TV; they give concerts with professional orchestras, and they have recently enjoyed tours of Paris, Berlin, Prague, Malta and even the USA. And, of course, their membership of one of the most beautiful places of worship in Lancashire gives them an unparalleled environment in which to spend their formative years.

In recent years we have developed an exciting programme of music outreach to schools in the Diocese. The Friends of Blackburn Music also promotes an imaginative concert series and Blackburn Cathedral Old Choristers' Association is a thriving body, which meets for fellowship and also supports the musical life of the Cathedral.

**The Cathedral Choir of Men and Boys** sings the majority of the choral services, presenting an ambitious repertoire that encompasses a broad range of styles from plainchant to present day. The choir also undertakes tours, recordings and broadcasts on national radio and television. Many of the choir men have sung in the Cathedral as a boy, returning to the choir after some years away. The boys have a demanding schedule, singing evensong every Wednesday in addition to their weekend duties with the choir men and participation in outreach work with local primary schools.

**The Girls' Choir** has a successful programme of its own, singing evensong on a number of Tuesdays and Thursdays every month, as well as providing music for other services as required and undertaking concerts, tours, recordings and broadcasts. The girls sing many services on their own, but often also sing with the Gentlemen of the Cathedral Choir.

**The Cathedral's Young People's Choir** is made up of former boys from the Cathedral Choir whose voices have changed and a top line of girls, many of whom also sing in the Girls' Choir. The YPC sings at the 9am Parish Eucharist every Sunday, as well as singing services and concerts at various times of the year in other churches around the Blackburn Diocese.

**The Schola Cantorum** comprises tenors and basses from the Young People's Choir. They specialise in singing plainsong, such as the Advent *O Antiphons* at the Advent Carol Service and at Monday Evensongs in Lent.

**Blackburn Cathedral Consort** has been formed in 2010 to sing Choral Evensong on Fridays at 5.15pm during Lent. The Consort is a relatively small group comprising some of the best local adult singers and exists to sing Liturgical music only. The repertoire of the Consort is broad and challenging and singers need to have excellent sight-reading skills because there is only 35 minutes rehearsal for each service.

**The Renaissance Singers**, directed by Richard Tanner, is a mixed adult chamber choir, fulfilling a busy programme of concerts (often with orchestras) and singing occasional services at the Cathedral. The Choir is regularly invited to broadcast by the BBC, most recently being Sunday Worship on BBC Radio 4 on June 14th 2009 in a programme to mark the 80th birthday of Anne Frank with excerpts from James Whitbourn's Oratorio "Annelies".

**Lantern Voices** are two choirs for boys and girls. They meet on Thursdays at 4.30pm as part of Blackburn Cathedral's Music Outreach Project. These choirs offer an excellent introduction to singing and present a very broad repertoire of music. Joy Fielding directs a choir for 4-7 year olds and Gill Fourie directs a choir for 7-11 year olds.

**Blackburn Cathedral's Music Outreach Project (MOP)** is run in conjunction with Blackburn with Darwen Music Service, Lancashire Music Service and Sing Up! (the Government's national singing programme for primary school aged children). It's a programme to make sure that singing is at the heart of every primary school child's life. We believe that singing has power to change lives and help to build stronger communities.

MOP has three different strands which can help children discover their voices. School Visits, Outreach Concerts and Lantern Voices. We offer Animateur sessions in which our team of experts visit primary schools to lead workshops in singing. Once a term a group of boy and girl choristers from Blackburn Cathedral Choir join the Animateurs for sessions in Primary Schools. In doing these sessions we hope to pass on expertise to the teaching staff at school so that they can take what we do further.

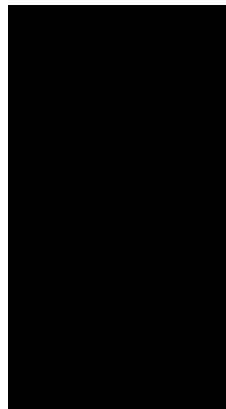
Once a term we put on an Outreach Concert at the Cathedral. We involve children from the schools that our Animateurs have visited that term. Choristers from Blackburn Cathedral's Boys, Girls and Lantern Voices choirs also take part in the concert. We also give a demonstration of our world famous organ and some children get to have a go on it.

The **Friends of Blackburn Cathedral Music** promote orchestral Masses within the context of worship, as well as an ambitious concert series at the Cathedral, providing not only wonderful education opportunities for Cathedral Choristers to sing great choral works with leading orchestras (chiefly the Northern Chamber Orchestra and the period instrument ensemble, Canzona), but also enriching the spiritual and cultural experiences of local people. FoBCM works in partnership with a number of local businesses to make this possible. We also collaborate with *exChange* (the Community Cohesion, Education, Outreach and Interfaith development agency of Blackburn Cathedral) to bring creative musical presentations to the community. In addition, FoBCM seeks to raise funds to enable choristers to learn musical instruments and take part in choir tours abroad. FoBCM also publishes a newsletter.

**Visiting Choirs.** We welcome visits from choirs who wish to sing when the choirs of the Cathedral are unavailable. Singing at the Cathedral is rewarding, particularly as there is a fine organ to accompany the choir and a wonderful acoustic for choral music. Choirs must be able to sing psalms, responses, settings of the canticles and anthems at Evensong, and music for the Communion if singing at 10.30 Eucharist on Sunday.
