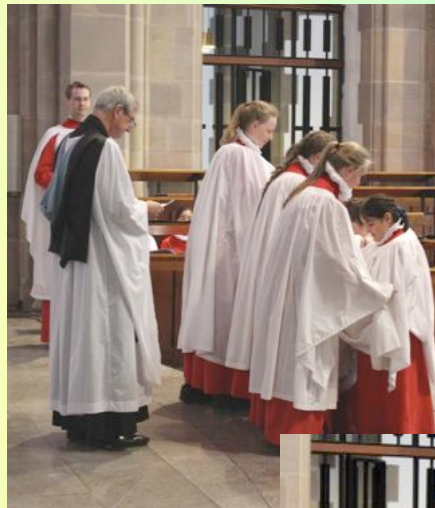
was raised to the status of Deputy Head Chorister.



The new Prefects were **Clara Slater** and **Elizabeth Fielding**



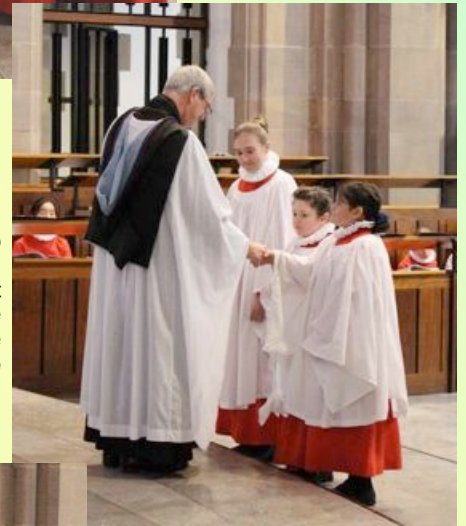
Olivia Grady and **Isabelle Barnes**
